

# Diabetic supplies covered under the SONH Aetna Medicare Advantage PPO ESA Plan

## Blood sugar self-testing equipment and supplies

Your Aetna Medicare Advantage PPO plan covers Medicare Part B blood sugar (also called blood glucose) self-testing equipment and supplies as durable medical equipment. It's covered even if you don't use insulin, as long as you have a prescription from your doctor. Self-testing supplies include:

- Blood sugar monitors (fingerstick type)
- Blood sugar test strips
- Lancet devices and lancets
- Glucose control solutions for checking the accuracy of testing equipment and test strips

## Other diabetic services and supplies covered as DME

You can obtain these from a Medicare DME provider:

- Diabetic insulin pump
- Continuous blood glucose monitors
- Therapeutic shoes or inserts

## Where can I get these supplies?

- Order and pick up at your pharmacy.
- Order from a Medicare durable medical equipment (DME) supplier.
- Order a home delivery supply from CVS Caremark® Mail Service Pharmacy.
- Call Aetna® for refills or send in an order form.

## Insulin and supplies for use with an insulin pump

Your Aetna Medicare Advantage PPO plan covers Medicare Part B insulin and supplies for use with insulin.

## Where can I get my insulin and supplies for my insulin pump?

- Order and pick up your supplies at your pharmacy.
- Order a home delivery supply from CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy.
- Call Aetna for refills or send in an order form.

## Diabetic supplies and insulin not used in an insulin pump are covered under the Express Scripts Medicare Part D Rx plan

## What you will need to pay

For most supplies covered by your Aetna Medicare Advantage plan, you'll first have to pay the Medicare Part B calendar year deductible. Once you have met the deductible, you'll have a \$0 contribution for these benefits for the rest of that calendar year. Effective January 1, 2022, the deductible is \$203. Call the number on your Aetna medical ID card to confirm how your supplies can be covered by Medicare Part B and to learn more about these benefits.

Aetna Medicare is a HMO, PPO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in our plans depends on contract renewal. See Evidence of Coverage for a complete description of plan benefits, exclusions, limitations and conditions of coverage. Plan features and availability may vary by service area.
